Greetings!

Thank you for caring about the Senior Center in Central Park and the people we serve. Though a global pandemic required us to close our doors we never stopped serving the population most affected by COVID-19, our senior community.

During the closure we provided more than 100,000 meals by employing a drive-through distribution process serving hundreds weekly. Twice monthly, Center staff prepared a 'Senior Center Activity Box' for a drive-through at the Center. Drive-in concerts turned our parking lot into a Senior Center without walls! Transportation services were available for ongoing medical needs. We assisted local communities with over 2,000 COVID-19 vaccinations. Our care managers stayed in contact with, and coordinated support for, the frail and elderly during their most challenging time of need. We never missed a day of Home Delivered Meals.

Most importantly, we never lost hope. We looked forward to the day when we could open the Center's doors and be together once again.

We are grateful to announce that day has arrived. We are back. Our doors are open!

The Center is the answer to the isolation that so many of our seniors faced. Classes are happening, the Hoag Health and Wellness Pavilion is open, and community activities are on the calendar. Social Services staff continue to assist seniors to remain independent. For the remainder of the year, the Senior Center in Central Park will play a vital role in helping seniors reconnect with their local community.
